Poltair Achieve South West Regional Rowing Success

28 pupils competed in the South West Indoor Rowing Championships on Tuesday 26th February 2008 in Plymouth.

The competition included schools from all over the south west, with pupils in Y7, Y8, Y9, Y10 and Y11 rowing for 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 minutes respectively. Competitors have to cover the greatest distance they can in the set time and have a target 'Gold Standard' to work towards, which is based upon Olympic times and distances.

We had some outstanding results, with Jessica Newson winning the Y7 girls competition, rowing 500m in just 2 minutes and Alex Welland winning the Y11 boys title, rowing 1805m in 6 minutes. Both Alex and Jessica achieved over 100% of the gold standard, which puts them amongst the most talented rowers in the country.

Benjamin Welland and Abigail Caple achieved 99% of the gold standard for their events, but the standard was so high that they achieved 5th and 3rd places respectively.

Other notable performances - Harriet Caple, 5th, Charlotte Cutlan 4th and Sean Pickering 10th.

The level of effort and determination from all pupils was rewarded with an overall 2^{nd} place. The girls' teams came 2^{nd} and the Year 7 team won the Project Oarsome Cup.

There has been a huge amount of work done by the Castle Dore rowing club members and the pupils involved. They will continue their training on Fridays in school and on the water in the summer and we look forward to more success in the future.
