17—21 November

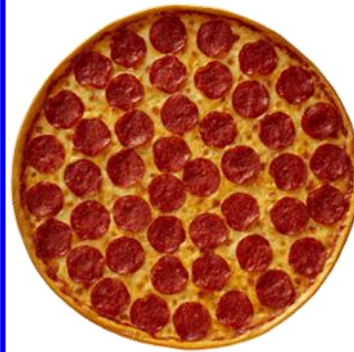

You have a pizza and a pizza cutter. If you can cut in only straight lines, what is the most number of pieces you can create with 3 cuts?

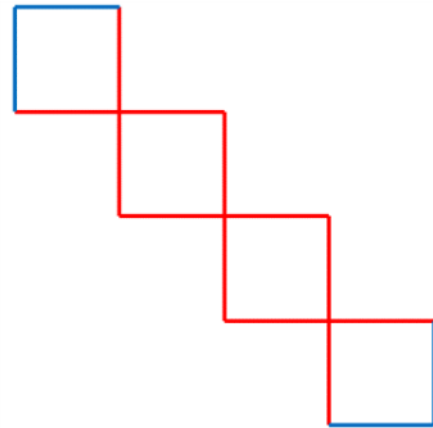
