Science High Starters

We ran a highly successful year 7/8 and 10 high starters evening looking at the structure of DNA. We looked at how DNA is organised in our cells and how genetic code is organised. Students then modelled (very successfully) their own DNA strands with sweets. Which was incredibly popular.

We then looked at how DNA is used to solve crime, by comparing the genetic codes of suspects and DNA found at the crime scene. We did this using statistics and by comparing the genetic codes. The students then went on to solve several crimes and identify the families of victims through the use of DNA technology.
