Abbie Shand Celebrates Excellent Sporting Achievements

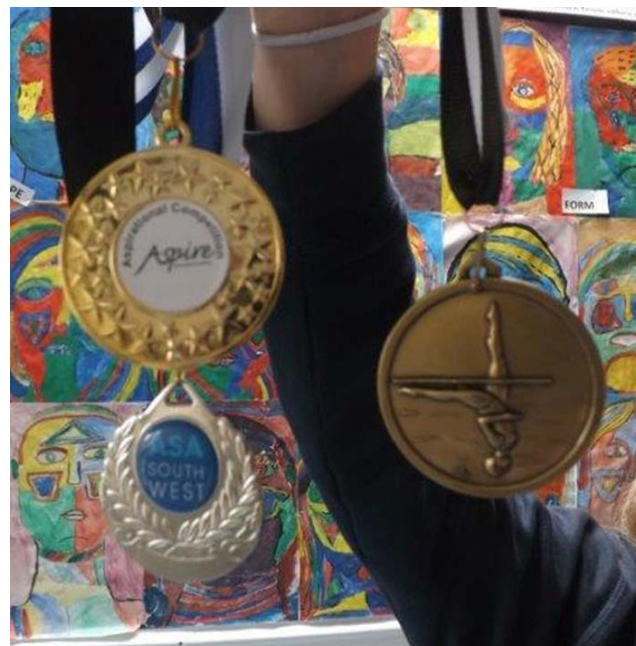
Staff and students would like to congratulate Abbie Shand on her excellent sporting achievements.
