SUGGESTED PACKING LIST – SURVIVAL & BUSHCRAFT RESIDENTIAL CAMP

MAIN PACKING REQUIREMENT

There is no requirement for good clothing, older clothes are ideal.

Rucksack or Large Bag

Sleeping Bag (good quality) (ex military ideal)

Old clothing spare

Spare Underwear

Spare Socks

Wet Weather Gear (waterproof top & trousers)

Cold Weather Clothing (night time) Fleece or woollen jumper

Woolly Hat (beanie) (staying warm at night if the temperature drops)

Head Torch (essential)

Stout Footwear (trainers) (walking boots)

Washing Kit (towel, tooth brush, tooth paste, soap, hair brush, etc)

Gloves (gardening gloves ideal) (builders gloves) soft hands, fire wood, shelters etc

MOBILE TELEPHONES TABLETS

Mobile phones and tablets are not allowed at Camp. They detract from the experience, cannot be charged on site, and become a security issue.

Poltair staff will be contactable in case of emergency and parents/carers will be provided with these emergency contact details closer to the time.

PROHIBITED

Please do not send your child to residential camp with:

- energy drinks
- knives
- pen knives
- fire lighters
- axes
- saws
- lighters
- bags of sweets
