



We have received information from the Police on a number of occasions that Carlyon Bay beach is an area of concern with regard to the safety of large groups of young people who are congregating there. This seems to involve young people from all local secondary schools from across all year groups. Of particular concern is the large amount of alcohol being consumed, use of some illegal substances and some incidents of sexual harm. I intend to meet with safeguarding leads from all local schools, the Police, the Council and representatives from Carlyon Bay to discuss the issues and consider how we can contribute to keeping our young people safe. In the meantime, I thought it was important to share our concerns with you.
