Self-isolating students return to school

Dear Parent,

You may be aware that the Government changed the guidance for self-isolation from 14 days to 10 days from the 14.12.20. As a result, we are pleased to be able to welcome back your child to school from Wednesday, 16th December.

This will give students the opportunity to return learning materials that have been worked on during self-isolation to their teachers, to re-join lessons on Wednesday 16th and Thursday 17th and to participate in tutor group activities and the Santa Fun Run on Friday 18th prior to finishing the term at midday.

We appreciate that there may be some parents that are reluctant to allow their child to return to school following this period of self-isolation and the closeness to the end of term and the Christmas holiday.

If your child continues to self-isolate, please confirm this through using the normal absence line or by emailing our Attendance Officer, Mrs Barrett-Reynolds on attendance@poltair.cornwall.sch.uk.

In the meantime, your child should continue to access the learning activities set by their teachers via ClassCharts. A guide to 'Learning from Home' and resources to support online work have been sent home to students.
