FREE SCHOOL MEALS – LUNCH PROVISION

Dear Parent/carer,

Poltair school has been liaising with its CELT partner schools and Chartwells Catering contractors to co-ordinate plans to support the provision of lunches to children registered for Free School Meals (FSM) during this period of school closure. We can confirm that the plan for this is now in place. Poltair School will be the hub for distribution of Free School Meal lunches delivered and packaged by Chartwells. On each Tuesday, starting tomorrow, Chartwells will distribute a 5 day packed lunch provision for each child registered for Free School Meals. Collection by parents of the weekly provisions will be from the Poltair school canteen delivery point which is to the left of the main school reception entrance (metal gate immediately facing you on entering the school site from Poltair park end). To manage distribution to parents effectively and to support the need for appropriate social distancing (2 metres apart) while lunch provisions are collected by parents, we are asking that parent arrive at Poltair within the stated timeframe – See Below. We appreciate that this timeframe may appear tight however there a large number of parents expected to arrive for collection. And in following Government guidance and with a respect for the welfare of all at this time we wish to maintain a level of co-ordination that protects you, your family and others. For parents of pupils registered as FSM and living in the following areas please arrive at the time stated:

St Austell (east) - 11.30am to 12pm

Roche/Stenalees/Bodmin - 12pm to 12.30pm

Par/St Blazey/St Dennis/Nanpean/Foxhole - 12.30pm to 1pm

Bugle/Penwithick - 1pm to 1.30pm

St Austell (west) - 1.30pm to 2pm

We hope that you are able to get to school at this time tomorrow to collect your child/children's FSM lunches. We are not able to deliver so the plan allows for collection only by those registered as parents of FSM children. Any uncollected provisions will be given to the local food bank each week. If you believe that you will not be able to collect, then please email the school at secretary@poltair.cornwall.sch.uk and we will consider any obstacles however we are at this time not able to offer an alternative to the plan in place.
