FREE SCHOOL MEALS – LUNCH PROVISION – 30th MARCH 2020

Dear Parent/carer,

Poltair school has been liaising with its CELT partner schools and Chartwells Catering contractors to co-ordinate plans to continue to support the provision of lunches to children registered for Free School Meals (FSM). We can confirm that the plan for the week of 30th March is now agreed. Poltair School will continue to be the hub for distribution of Free School Meal lunches delivered by Chartwells for Poltair FSM pupils.

On **Monday 30th March** (not Tuesday as provisionally advised in the previous communication) Chartwells will distribute a 10-day lunch provision for each child registered for Free School Meals. Chartwells have listened to feedback following this week's distribution and made adjustments to the new package.

Collection by parents of this 10-day provision will again be from the Poltair School canteen delivery point, which is to the left of the main school reception entrance (metal gate immediately facing you on entering the school site from Poltair park end). To manage distribution to parents effectively and to support the need for appropriate social distancing (2 metres apart) while lunch provisions are collected by parents, we are asking that parents arrive at Poltair within the stated timeframe – See Below. For parents of pupils registered as FSM and living in the following areas please arrive at the time stated:

St Austell (East – Gover Valley/Bodmin Rd/Bridge Rd/East Hill/Trewoon) - 11.30am to 12pm

Roche/Stenalees/Bodmin - 12pm to 12.30pm

Par/St Blazey/St Dennis/Nanpean/Foxhole - 12.30pm to 1pm

Bugle/Penwithick - 1pm to 1.30pm

St Austell (West – Slades Rd/Carclaze/Boscoppa/Bethel/Mountcharles/Holmbush) - 1.30pm to 2pm

We hope that you are able to get to school at these times on **Monday 30th January** to collect your child/children's 10 day FSM provision. We are not able to deliver so the plan allows for collection only. If you are unable to collect personally then hopefully friends or family can support. Chartwells will accept collection if you give approval for this via text to the person collecting. Any uncollected provisions will be given to the local food bank. If you believe that you will not be able to collect, then please email the school at secretary@poltair.cornwall.sch.uk and we will consider any obstacles however we are at this time not able to offer an alternative to the collection plan in place. Do bear in mind that we receive a lot of emails at secretary@ and although monitored daily we cannot always respond immediately but will get back to you within 48 hours.
