Poltair School organised an amazing ‘Super Sixes Summer School’ to aid the transition from Primary to Secondary School. The programme was offered to all 160 students transitioning up to Poltair in September 2021 as a fun packed week from 16th August – 20th August. To ensure this programme was successful, the schools current year 7 Transition ambassador team of 30 students where offered the chance to undertake a weeks’ worth of training from the 9th August – 13th August to enable them to have the confidence to support the Year 6 students the following week.

The programme had a theme running throughout the week of ‘Tortoises’. Each student took part in sessions lead by the Maths, English, Science, Drama, Design Tech, Art and PE departments. Each session allowed students to collaboratively work together and make new friends. Students also had the opportunity to tour the school and meet key members of staff including their tutor for the coming year.
